'A DAY WITH THE KIDS!'

The joys of reopening schools amidst Corona virus Pandemic was welcomed with lots of precautions, hand sanitization, masks, checking of temperatures, social distancing... and the list goes on and on. Call of Molo staff were happy to resume full day duties and cook hot meals to give lunch to the 56 kids we feed from the three Primary Schools. While some kids moved to other locations, we had the opportunity to meet and enroll some new kids to our feeding program.

This reopening of the schools in January led to a guidance and counseling day in the Call of Molo grounds, whereby we invited boys and girls, 11 years and older from the three schools we feed to join us for some treats and to be guided and counseled on matters affecting/pertaining to them at this age. The day started with prayers and a devotion, followed by them being separated into different groups and our esteem Advisory Board members offered counseling to them. After lunch, girls received sanitary towels and the boys received boxers and both genders received, clothing, shoes, personal hygiene items.
