Brenda was unwell on 13/10/2021 a situation that was quickly responded to and is now in good health now.

On 14/10/2021 C.O.M rescued Margaret Adhiambo Juma a 16 year old girl who is expectant. She will be with us for a period of 1 month.

On 19/10/2021 C.O.M. rescued Sharon Chemngetich a 16 year old who is an abuse case. She will be with us for a period of two months.

- **FARM REPORT**

Zawadi the cow produces a maximum of 9-10liters of milk a day, we thank God for that. She was given an A.I. on 12/10/2021 we hope for positive outcome on the same.

Baraka the calf is turned 5 months old on 14/10/2021 and is feeding on solids food and supplements such as Napier grass , Hay, Grass as well as water. On the garden we have planted crops such as peas which have been consumed on three occasions, potatoes, carrots, cabbages, kales and spinach which help in the feeding program on daily basis. From the above information it's evident that we are still on the right path and will achieve more with GOD on our side.
