The parents are casual workers who earn their livings as laborers in private farms. It's so unfortunate since their earnings isn't enough to cater for the family basic needs which makes it difficult for the children to their education.

Eunice Njeri is in class seven, Mary Wanjiku class five; Samuel Kimani class three and Joseph Nga'nga in class one. The children have been in our program for a period of 2 years and we have observed a lot of great improvement in their health situation, psychosocial behavior and education. The children are physically healthy and their emotional and social behavior and academic has improved in school and at home.

### **Challenges associated with the family**

Finances: The family has financial constraints, both parents' earnings from their daily wages is not enough to take care of basic needs for the family.
