

## **NOVEMBER 2021 FEEDING PROGRAM REPORT.**

### **INTRODUCTION**

Greetings to all in Christ our Lord's Name. The following is a list of events of phase three of term two-year 2021, having taken the power of GOD and cooperation from each and every member of Call Of Molo the events are as follows:

- **FEEDING PROGRAM**

Feeding program for children at Kambala, St. Mary's and Moto primary were carried out very well during the month where lunch for the children was delivered at the respective schools on time.

This program comprises of 62 children in total where, 17 are in Kambala, 19 in St Mary's and 27 in Moto primary school.

Firewood was delivered to Call Of Molo that will be used for cooking and getting food ready for children in the Feeding program as well as those in the home/rescue center program.

We paid for the pupils (students) exams fees for their midterm exams which kicked off on November 19<sup>th</sup> 2021.

Follow up for the pupils (students) who had missed school was continuously carried out to find out the reasons preventing them from attending school. It was discovered that most of the children had fees arrears and were staying at home waiting for their parents/guardians to clear or reduce part of the school fee balance.

- **RESCUE CENTRE REPORT**

At the beginning of the month the program supported 4 rescued children: 3 girls and 1 boy. The boy by the name of King'ori has continues doing well in school, he is studying hard, and continues to attend EPAKAM primary school. Despite a difficult start where he used to become last position, he has improved remarkably to position 25 out of the possible 36.

The girls attended classes at the center, were counseled, had life skill lessons and proper hygiene among other lessons.

One of the girls who was rescued while pregnant has been blessed with a baby boy and mom and child are in good health.

- **FARM REPORT**

Zawadi the cow produces a maximum of 13 liters of milk per day and together with Baraka, they are feeding on solids food and supplements such as Napier grass, Hay, Grass as well as drinking water. In October Zawadi the cow received an A.I. which was unsuccessfully unviable and has received another AI this month in the hope of a positive outcome on December 10<sup>th</sup> 2021.

The garden has been planted Cabbages, spinach and leaf onions which will help the feeding program on daily basis. There has been water shortage in the well, tanks and water spring near the Organization due to lack of rain.

- **CONCLUSION**

From the above information it's evident that we are still on the right path and will achieve more with GOD on our side.

- **RECOMMENDATION**
