Kambala Primary School we've got two candidates that is Wilson Kinuthia and Eunice Muthoni. St Mary's Primary School we have only one candidate Perister Wambui. We are hoping for the best as they will be sitting for their exams march next month.

### **ADDITION OF CHILDREN IN THE PROGRAM.**

Several home assessments have taken place this month and we have managed to add four children from Kenyatta village. Currently the numbers are 26 children from Moto primary, 13 from Kambala Primary School and 17 children from St Mary's Mixed Primary. We still progressing with home visits and we hope to add more children, because our aim is to reach out to as many children as we will be capable of.

### **GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING.**

Guidance and counseling session for children in the program aged 12-18 years under the Call Of Molo program took place and the attendance was satisfactory, 27 students from three schools availed themselves. The board and staff members facilitated the sessions with different topics affecting the teenagers. Later on the attendants were offered with different goodies which were hygiene kits to both genders. Moreover, girls were given sanitary pads and underwear's while the boys underwear's. In addition, Jitegemee Hardware (Mama John) and PEMU Mali Mali donated home clothes and shoes which were issued to the children on the same day. May the Almighty God bless everyone who contributed to the success of this day.

### **ACHIEVEMENTS.**

We have registered consistent school attendance from the children, by their schoolteachers. Number of children in the program has increased with four children adding up to 56.

There is a tremendous progress as far as this program is concerned as evidenced by feed backs from guardians/parents and children. This is an achievement to us since its one of the main visions and mission of our program.
