### 'HEAR THEIR STORIES!'

Paul Gachichio joined our feeding program in 2019 September. Our Social Worker Susan came to know him through the schoolteachers from St. Mary's Mixed Primary School. Paul was living in a wooden rental shack by himself and barely had anything. He has no known father but his mother lives in another town and it's questionable if she is mentally stable. Paul has a sister who is being sponsored by the Molo Area Member of Parliament employee. His older brother Peter lives by himself in a nearby town known as Turi. After class eight completion in November 2019 and with results at hand Paul having no other place to go, came to Call of Molo and pleaded for help. Our chairlady took him in and someone volunteered to pay for his high school fees, a number of people joined efforts from Call for Molo to get him started in his new journey. Paul goes to schools at Njenga Karume Secondary School, Paul is struggling academically. After going through his school report card, we realized a drastic drop in grades mostly in Math's, Physics and Business Studies and after a lengthy discussion he promised to perform better in each subject. He will receive counseling and he promised to do away with some friends of his that were not a good influence. Paul will be living with his brother as they help each other in education and hopefully through their mom's meagre earnings she can be supporting them with basic needs and also hopefully pay for Peter's (Paul's brother) schools fees which he is in arrears.

Above is pictures of 3 girls representing the 3 schools we feed. The first girl in a green sweater is from Kambala Primary School, the girl in the middle in a blue sweater is from St. Mary's Mixed Primary School and the girl in the last picture is from Moto Primary School. The girls are receiving some sanitary towels donated by Priscilla and her friends from Texas and Georgia. Some of the struggles our girls have is the need for sanitary pads but now the problem is resolved glory to God.

Breaking NEWS! Zawadi 'Gift' the cow gave birth to a bouncing heifer calf by the name of Baraka 'Blessing'. Zawadi in the above picture is a proud mom and on top

of raising Baraka, she is producing 10 to 16 liters of milk per day hence has offset our budget of purchasing milk for the organization. We plan on selling the extra milk and the proceeds will go towards buying cow feeds or the cow and its calf veterinary needs.

The New Children's Officer, in Molo, Mr. Njagi invited us to attend the day of the African child celebration on Wednesday June 16<sup>th</sup> 2021. This is a yearly celebration to commemorate the girl child apartheid in South Africa many years ago. Continue to pray for the Children's offices in Kenya.
